

BIAMC Puget Sound Policy: Authorized Patches and Conditions

I. Authorization

A. Chapter patches are authorized per National and Chapter Bylaws

II. Patches

A. FBBF Forever Brothers/Brothers Forever

1. This Nationally available patch is available for all chapter members in good standing.

B. Original Chapter Patch

1. May be worn by all current and retired members of the Puget Sound chapter.
2. Members who leave the Original Chapter are asked to remove the patch from their cut, but are not asked to surrender the patch.
3. It may be displayed on articles other than cut.

C. Roadhog

1. Only one Roadhog patch is awarded each year. It will be awarded to the person who has logged the most miles on their motorcycle determined by odometer readings reported to the Secretary.
2. Each year, in January, patch-holders in good standing may send their current odometer mileage to the Chapter Secretary. In the case that a member has multiple motorcycles, he/she may submit all club qualifying motorcycle's odometer readings.
3. Each year, the day after the Olympia Toy Run, those participating may send their new odometer reading to the chapter secretary, to compare and calculate the mileage over the year.
4. Patch shall be awarded at December's Church
5. If the award falls to an individual who has already earned the Roadhog patch, he will receive, instead, a gold star device for each subsequent award.
6. Exceptions: If a motorcycle is known to be used by a non-patch holding member, that mileage should be excluded through appropriate reporting to the secretary. If such exceptions are not documented, the mileage from that vehicle shall not be counted. A brother who rides another brother's motorcycle, for any reason, is granting that mileage to the owner.
